

**Standardized Mode of Dress for Students at
Marlin Junior Academy
Grades 6 – 8
To be Effective the 2018 – 2019 School Year**

The standardized mode of dress is as follows:

Shirts:

- Polo-type (collared) shirts must be solid in any color, **not stripes or other designs**
- Must have sleeves – long or short

Pants and Shorts/Skirts:

- Black, navy, or tan only, **not camouflage or any other designs**
- Shorts/skirts must be no more than 3” above the knee
- Must be proper waist size and worn at the waist; no sagging
- Cut-off, frayed or un-hemmed garments are not permitted; no holes of any kind in bottoms

Additional Information:

- Solid, plain sweatshirts or sweaters are permitted to be worn over the polo shirts; **no stripes or any other designs or emblems**
- Heavy coats are to be worn outside during cold weather, but will not be permitted to be worn during instructional class times
- Light Jackets or wind breakers may be worn in the building, but must be a **solid** color; **no stripes or any other designs or emblems**
- Hoods or hats are not to be worn in the building
- Open-toe shoes, such as sandals (or backless shoes), house shoes, or slippers are not permitted

Expectations for Standardized Mode of Dress

Students will be expected to follow the standardized mode of dress **Monday through Thursday**. Students may wear jeans ***and*** Marlin Bulldog spirit gear ***or*** college spirit gear on **Fridays only**. *If a student is not wearing spirit gear, that student will be expected to follow the standardized mode of dress (same as Mon. – Thursday).

Students are expected to wear closed toe shoes.

Brand names or logos on shirts or pants are not to be larger than 2 sq. Inches.

Student violations of the standardized mode of dress will be addressed just as any other conduct violation and will be resolved in accordance with the student code of discipline.
