Dear Parents,

In 1995, the Texas Legislature created the Public Education Grant (PEG) program. The PEG program permits parents whose children attend schools on the PEG list to request that their children transfer to schools in other districts.

Due to unsatisfactory performance in the domain of Student Achievement and School Progress, Marlin Primary Academy is among the schools that the State has designated as PEG schools. This means that parents of any student at this campus is eligible to transfer to schools in other non-PEG districts without paying tuition/fees to that district.

Parents may request a transfer to another district by contacting that district, in writing, to request a transfer. This letter, as well as the fact that the campus is on the State PEG list, is adequate justification for requesting the transfer.

Marlin ISD is committed to providing all students with a quality education, and to continuous improvement of each school. The collaborative efforts of students, parents, staff, and community organizations will ensure that all students at Marlin Elementary receive the best education possible.
